




NOTARGIACOMO DESIGN DESKTOP LAMPS

With the assistance of Lavori Argenti Romani (a celebrated company based in the heart of Rome and known for creating tailor-made lampshades since 1938), Notargiacomo has developed exciting functional decoration with a twist, ideal for the discerning petrolhead. His latest offerings are the 'Discobrake Porsche' and the 'Porsche Frame' pictured here (alongside the man himself). The creation of the former starts with the recovery of a carbon-ceramic brake disc, which is supported by a transparent methacrylate sheet. At the top, a laser-cut lamphada features in opal white, while the translucent base features a fixed vintage Porsche crest. Both lampshade and base are metacrylate. The Porsche Frame, meanwhile, features a North American early Porsche license plate corner with an LED light, a black and gold methacrylate base, plus a fixed classic early Porsche hubcap badge.




RECOMMENDED READ: F1 THE LEGENDS

With a foreword by Red Bull Racing boss, Christian Horner, this 240-page hardback from author, Tony Dorigo, profiles legendary Grand Prix drivers from across every decade of Formula One, outlining their triumphs, tragedies and the lasting impact they've left not only on the top tier of motorsport, but also racing in general. Of particular interest to Porscheophiles is the inclusion of Dan Gurney, the former Stuttgart works driver who piloted the Rot-eight-powered Type R04 to victory at the 1962 French Grand Prix, scoring Porsche's only win in F1 as a constructor. The brand's triumph as an engine supplier to McLaren is a far more celebrated story of success, resulting in the Marlboro-sponsored Woking concern winning two constructor's championships, dozens of race wins and three driver's titles, the latter distributed between Alain Prost and Niki Lauda, both of whom are featured in this cleanly designed book. Other drivers showcased include Ascari, Fangio, Moss, Hawthorn, Brabham, Graham Hill, McLaren, Surtees, Clark, Stewart, Rindt, Andretti, Fittipaldi, Hart, Jones, Gilles Villeneuve, Piquet, Mansell, Senna, Häkkinen, Schumacher, Damon Hill, Button, Alonso, Räikkönen, Rosberg, Vettel, Hamilton and Verstappen.
